### **President's Remarks:**

Paul Wright reflected on the recent growth of disc golf and the benefits that the sport has provided for the community. ### NAD Park - [Course Guide](#)

Several holes on the course are in need of wood chips. The baskets are currently in the "B" positions. Baskets are scheduled to move to the "A" position in mid-April.

### DIScovery

Course is open. All course improvements projects are postponed.

### Kitsap Fairgrounds - [Course Guide](#)

The WSDGA is in the planning phases to add alternate tee areas. The Phase II Master Plan needs to be approved by Kitsap County Parks. Reminder: No power tools allowed per Kitsap County Parks Department. Paul Wright has scheduled a course walk through on April 20th with the Kitsap County park volunteer steward to discuss the course improvements planned in Phase II of the Kitsap DGC Master Plan.

### Bud Pell at Ross Farm - [Course Guide](#)

Course closure update: June 2021 is the new expected permanent course closure date with possible extension into the Summer months. The additional 9 Throw Pink holes are now installed by borrowing baskets from the Bainbridge DGC. The Bud Pell course will be a 27 hole layout until the official permanent course closure date. The WSDGA discussed the grass mowing plan. Volunteers are needed for grass mowing.

### Van Zee Park - [Course Guide](#)

All course improvement projects are postponed until Summer 2021 (tee sign replacements, basket re-location for holes 1, 2, and 5, and new alternate tee areas for hole 2 and 6). City fence needs work by Hole 3 tee area. POC is Sam Huff.

### Horseshoe Lake Golf Course - [Course Guide](#)

The Lakeside and Canyon courses are looking great. Groups are expected to complete a round of 18 holes in 2 hours (2 ½ hours maximum), which will most likely be groups of 2 or 3 players. Tee Times available in the afternoon. Call for play availability (253-857-3326). The Lakeside course improvements for 2021 are complete. New basket locations for holes 1, 6, 7, 10, 13, 16, and 17. New tee locations for hole 5 and 8. The Canyon course has two new basket locations for holes 4 and 15. The Canyon course is planned to get another six concrete tee areas this Summer before the Wild West Shootout on September 25 & 26, 2021.

### Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC Master Plan

Sam Huff is working on the updated master plan for Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC to submit to the parks department for future development for Phase II and III. June 2021 ETA.

### Adopt-a-Hole Stewardship Program

Adopt-a-Hole general course steward program. Allegra Archer is the program lead and is working on the standards and guidelines for volunteers to follow. Once the COVID-19 course restrictions are lifted, the program will be rolled out with formal details.
