Bremerton Parks wants to involve the WSDGA stewardship group with the discussion about N.A.D. parking and future improvements to Kitsap Way and Austin Drive. More information to come in 2024. Sam Huff and Prescott Mabbutt will attend the upcoming meetings with the Bremerton Parks Department to continue to build relationships.

Square Lake Disc Golf Proposal and Feedback

Nikole Coleman put together a proposal for the disc golf course at Square Lake. Sam Huff has continued to attend the meetings and advocate for disc golf. The next meeting is in October and Sam Huff will attend to give a presentation of the WSDGA proposal. With the preliminary proposal, the Coulter Creek Heritage park group comments were to add an introduction section and a few more small details within our proposal, including the “pros and cons” of disc golf, a proposal for an “exit strategy” in case the course ever were to close, how disc golf affects homeless encampments, and tourism.
