### **President's Remarks:**

With the current decline in COVID-19 cases, the community is reminded to be socially distant while playing. The WSDGA Board policy is to follow all park restrictions.

### **Comments from the Community:**

Rick Burns discussed that he represents a group on the Olympic Peninsula that is interested in forming a disc golf club and would like assistance from the WSDGA. The Board discussed several topics to guide the new club in the right direction. Sam Huff will send Rick Burns a copy of the WSDGA Bylaws to help in forming the new club.

## **Course Discussions:**

### NAD Park

Several holes on the course are in need of wood chips. Baskets are currently in the “B” positions. The baskets are scheduled to move to the “A” positions in mid-April.

### DIScovery

Course is open. All course improvements projects are postponed.

### Kitsap Fairgrounds

Board discussion about the potential new alternate tee areas. Master Plan needs to be approved by Kitsap County Parks. Reminder: No power tools allowed per Kitsap County Parks Department.

### Bud Pell at Ross Farm

Course closure update: May 2021 is the new expected permanent course closure date. The additional 9 Throw Pink holes are now installed by borrowing baskets from the Bainbridge DGC. The Bud Pell course is a 27 hole layout until the official permanent course closure date. NOTE: one of the temporary baskets was stolen. The WSDGA Board has reported the basket theft.

### Van Zee Park

All course improvement projects are postponed until Spring 2021 (tee sign replacements, basket re-location for holes 1, 2, and 5, and new alternate tee areas for hole 2 and 6). City fence needs work by Hole 3 tee area. POC is Sam Huff.

### Horseshoe Lake Golf Course

The Lakeside and Canyon courses are looking great. Groups are expected to complete a round of 18 holes in 2 hours (2 ½ hours maximum), which will most likely be groups of 2 or 3 players. The Lakeside course will see a few changes for 2021. New basket locations for holes 1, 6, 7, 10, and 17. The Canyon course is planned to get another six concrete tee areas this Spring before the Kitsap Classic tournament.

## **Old Business**

### Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC Master Plan

Sam Huff is working on the updated master plan for Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC to submit to the parks department for future development for Phase II and III.

### Adopt-a-Hole Stewardship Program

Adopt-a-Hole general course steward program. Allegra Archer is the program lead and is working on the standards and guidelines for volunteers to follow. Once the COVID-19 course restrictions are lifted, the program will be rolled out with formal details.

### Feather Banners

The design for the last four feather flags have been approved and waiting for printing.

### Ice Bowl “Food Drive”

The annual Ice Bowl event was postponed due to the pandemic. The WSDGA organized a “Food Drive” to continue the community support part of the event and collected a total of 248 pounds of food and \$700 cash for the Bremerton Food Line. The WSDGA thanks all the players for the community support.
