Sam Huff, Prescott Mabbutt, and Nikole Coleman are planning to meet with the City of Bremerton to continue building a relationship between the club and the Parks Department. Sam Huff removed the old Bud Pell number signs and corrected several of the "next tee" signs so they face the correct direction. The long term plan is to install the club's Red Chainstars baskets in the "A" position at NAD, by the end of the year.
