# **Course Discussions**

## N.A.D. Park DGC

After a few recent tournaments, we discussed the need for an additional log round for a water cooler placed at strategic places on the course for players during tournaments.

# **DISCovery DGC**

Course conditions are good. Dan Glynn is working with 360 Disc Golf to make signs for the footboards at each tee area. Dan brought the decals that the signs will be made out of and they look great. Scheduled completion date early Summer. Needs a resource for steel frames. Paul Wright will assist.

## Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC

Looking good from recent Spring maintenance. Eagle Scout project was approved for course benches and is on track for an early Summer completion date.

## Bud Pell at Ross Farm DGC

Looking good, mowing season is underway. Volunteers needed. Message Paul Wright to take the mower for test drive to keep the grass trimmed. After a few tee sign caps were found on the ground, Paul Wright will use a better method to secure the sign caps. REMINDER: Bud Pell DGC is a no smoking course. Someone recently threw a lit cigarette in a hollowed tree and was noticed to be smoldering by several players. They used their water bottles to prevent a full fire. ## Van Zee Park

## Horseshoe Lake Golf Course

15 of the new baskets are installed on the Canyon Course. The 27 holes for the Kitsap Classic are being prepped and are available to play. Disc golfers will have exclusive use Horseshoe Lake golf course on Friday, May 17th through to Sunday, May 19th for the WSDGA Membership Appreciation day and the PDGA A-Tier Kitsap Classic tournament. New basket flags have been installed for the Lakeside Course..

## East Bremerton DGC

Paul Wright has drafted a disc golf course design to submit to the Bremerton School Board for approval. A multi-use path through the park is currently approved and we are certain the course design will accommodate the path throughout the disc golf course. Paul will display the map as soon as it is approved. The planning process is slow and the WSDGA should know more next Spring. Paul is really going to push to get it started. Pitch and putt? 9 holes?

# Battle Point Park DGC, Bainbridge Island

The Bainbridge Island Disc Golf Club wrote an excellent proposal to Washington State Team Golf League asking if they would like to fund new baskets for the park. Washington State Team Golf League approved this proposal and was happy to provide the park with upgraded new baskets. The old baskets will be available to use if the Parks Board allows an additional 9 holes to be added to the disc golf course. Baskets received and will be installed this coming weekend.
