## **Course Discussions**

### N.A.D. Park DGC

A few trees are down from the recent Winter storms. Paul Wright will contact the City of Bremerton and see when they can get it cleaned up. He will also look into getting extra gate keys made so the Board has a multiple sets for course stewards. Some discussion about the basket rotation plan for the year. The Board agrees to keep with historical movements. The next basket move to the B locations will be mid-January.

### DISCOVERY DGC

Course conditions are good. Dan Glynn is working with 360 Disc Golf to make signs for the footboards at each tee sign.

### Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC

A tree is down between hole 16 and hole 10. Mr. Wright will assess and call the County, if needed. Greg Kelsay trimmed up the holly bush on hole 18 that was in need of returning back to the original hole design per the approval of the WSDGA Board.

### Bud Pell at Ross Farm DGC

Recent Winter storm resulted in a large quantity of branches down throughout the park. They can easily be cleared by people as they play the course. Lisa Nienhuser will go out and undecorate the Christmas tree. Gold teepads are getting good responses and the benches are in process. The Board motioned to reimburse Paul Wright for the bench materials. Motion Passed.

### Van Zee Park

The course is still closed due to construction in the park. Kiosk needs work when the park reopens. The park is scheduled to open to the public late February..

### Horseshoe Lake Golf Course

Sam Huff is adding OB on the left side of hole 9 to add more risk to the "shortcut". A second "West Sound" course is in the planning phases. The first opportunity to play the new course will be at the Wild West Shootout tournament on March 16.

## **Old Business**

### East Bremerton DGC

Paul Wright has drafted a disc golf course design to submit to the Bremerton School Board for approval. A multi-use path through the park is currently approved and we are certain the course design will accommodate the path throughout the disc golf course. Paul will display the map as soon as it is approved. The planning process is slow and the WSDGA should know more next Spring.

### Battle Point Park DGC, Bainbridge Island

Paul Wright is attending a meeting regarding concrete teepads. The club will loan the forms for teepads that were built for Bud Pell golds. Tony Beckett will assist in finishing the concrete.

### Tee Signs at Bud Pell DGC

Brian Johnson is working on a full course map for the kiosk and had questions about course size and map size. Tee signs for all three layouts are in final design stages and should be ready to install in the next couple of months.

### Deaf Disc Golf Nationals

Paul Wright was asked to be an assistant TD for the tournament. The dates for the event is August 1-3, 2019. The courses to be used will be N.A.D. Park and Bud Pell DGC.

Paul Wright stated that he will do more research and report back to the WSDGA Board.
