

## West Sound Series March 19 - August 27



Sam Huff writes, "Thanks to all who supported the 2016 West Sound Series. Through the Innova and Discraft fundraising disc program, \$3700 was raised and donated to the WSDGA. The mission of the West Sound Series is to encourage friendly competition among the local players by creating a format for individual play and a series of organized group events. Based on participation and feedback throughout the year, the West Sound Series is meeting its goal of bringing the disc golf community together at all skill levels. The season started

March 19th and finished on August 27th. New this year was the use of Horseshoe Lake Golf Course for a temporary disc golf course and all four events were PDGA sanctioned. There were a total of 191 unique players in the series and each Event was at full capacity. One prize was awarded at each Event round based on score. The rest of the prizes were awarded as door prizes and during event side games. After the Final Event, trophies were awarded based on the overall point totals from the best five round scores. Congratulations to Chris Holden (Advanced), Travis Magerstaedt (Intermediate), Levi Meikle (Recreational), Paul Wright (Grandmaster), Amanda Nelson (Women) in the Series Points Titles. Also, special thanks to all the players who helped at each Event. It takes a lot of help to make an event run smoothly."









League disc golf returned to the West Sound in 2016 in the form of the "Kitsap Summer League." Kyle Rife hosted the 10-week league from June 2 - August 4. Competitors played one round of singles each week in the Open, Advanced, Intermediate, and Women's Intermediate divisions. The entry was \$10 per week and players competed for season "points" (which were used to determine division champs and script) as well as for weekly prizes. Valholl Brewing sponsored one CTP hole each week, with the winner earning a \$20 voucher for use at their tap room in Poulsbo. 360 Disc Golf also sponsored a CTP contest, worth \$15 in-store credit (in addition to paying out the season script). In all, 56 different players played a total of 277 rated rounds in the Kitsap Summer League, and over \$1700 was paid out to the players in cash and merchandise. Congratulations to the champions: Justin Rinesmith (MPO), Brian Jacobs (MA1), Allegra Archer (FA1), and Allen Hewey (MA2).
