Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC Improvement Plan

Phase II of the Kitsap Fairgrounds DGC is playable with temporary tee signs and tee areas for the Blue and Red layouts. Course improvements will continue during the year.

New Course Developments

The WSDGA will continue to do everything we can to get disc golf into the Coulter Creek Heritage Park. North Kitsap Baptist Church has been working hard to clear the property to add a small 9 hole course. The design stage of the planning will be coming soon. Paul Wright and Prescott Mabbutt have offered to help them with design and anything else they might need. The Chief Kitsap Academy has approved a recreational 9 hole course with the potential for a separate challenging 18 hole course.
