Pressure washing / cleaning the tee pads is planned to be done this year. The basket for Hole 4 (A location) has been repaired and returned to the course.

Van Zee Park - Course Guide

The lost & found box is being refurbished and will be installed in the Spring. Brain Johnson has been working on new tee signs. The basket location for hole 1 is being discussed for a possible location to the right and in the trees to reduce erosion on the grass hillside at the current location.

New Course Developments

Coulter Creek Heritage Park - Sam Huff has been attending planning meetings and stewardship work efforts. Disc golf on the property is looking good. The 2024 Kitsap County Park Open Space Plan is being updated for more disc golf courses.

North Kitsap Baptist Church - Waiting on permission from the church board to begin the design phase.. The course is almost ready to get started. Prescott Mabbutt and Paul Wright will help the church design the course.

Chief Kitsap Academy - Approved a nine hole recreational course for the students. The WSDGA will assist in any way as needed. The Paul McBeth Foundation will also assist with building the course. There is a potential for a separate challenging 18 hole course.

Clear Creek - The property will be transferred to the City of Poulsbo this month. More information to come for a potential disc golf course.
