The hazardous tree on hole 13 has been removed by Kitsap Parks. The basket on hole 13 has been approved by the WSDGA Board to be moved longer at the next work party.

Sam Huff and Prescott Mabbutt will be meeting with Bremerton Parks to talk about erosion control and other long-term course improvement items. When the course map is updated the Board wants to add trail names for the existing trails in the park.

Sam Huff wants to move hole 1 basket for safety and erosion concerns. Safety netting on hole 5 and 8 is also a priority. The Lost and Found box will be installed this Winter.

Unfinished Business:

North Kitsap Baptist Church

Ready for design and course installation. Just waiting for final approval from the Church Board. WSDGA will assist when asked.

Coulter Creek Heritage Park (Square Lake)

Sam Huff is attending meetings and building relationships for the prospects of getting a disc golf course installed at the park. Nikole Coleman and Sam Huff are working on finalizing the proposal to present to the Kitsap County Parks Advisory Board.

Bremerton Parks Commissioners Meeting

Discussed the future of N.A.D. Park – the city wants to put a round-a-bout at the Kitsap way/Austin Dr. intersection. This will affect the NAD parking lot and discovery course. The city is willing to work with the WSDGA to make some improvements to the NAD property. This project is in the planning phase and will take several years.

Course Maps and Tee Signs

Brian Johnson is working on course maps. The Board discussed what a course map should look like for the kiosk. Taylor Foth will print the course maps when we are ready.

NAD Family Friendly Doubles (Saturday)

Dan Glynn is looking for a new host for the weekly doubles event at N.A.D Park.

Membership Tags

Current quotes are \$650 for membership tags. The Board would like to have them available by the Ice Bowl event. Dylan Jacot motioned to increase the budget to \$750. Seconded by Sam Huff and approved by the WSDGA Board.

Paul McBeth Foundation partner club opportunity

AED

Allegra Archer conducted a brief training session to the Board on the use of the AED. The AED and first aid kit will be stored at 360 Disc Golf in between WSDGA events.

Work Party Winter Schedule

The WSDGA Board plans to host a regular work party on the first Saturday of the month starting in November and ending in April at the Kitsap Fairgrounds disc golf park. The work party hours will be 9:00am to 12:00pm. Sam Huff motioned to allocate \$200 for work party materials. Dylan Jacot seconded. Motion approved.

Cedar Heights Middle School

A local WSDGA member reached out to Sam Huff about getting a recreational friendly course installed at CHMS. The principal has been interested in the past. If the school wants help or guidance from WSDGA we are happy to help.

New Business:

Basket Flags

Prescott Mabbutt wants to purchase basket flags for both sets of baskets at NAD Park and a set for Kitsap Fairgrounds Park. The Board is willing to keep brain storming how we could make that work in the most cost-effective way. More info to come. Allegra Archer wants to start with Kitsap Fairgrounds as the “tester course” before paying for all three sets of basket flags. Theft and vandalism is a concern.

PDGA Affiliate Club Renewal

Sam Huff has renewed the annual partnership with the PDGA to be an affiliate club.

Kitsap Park PROS Questionnaire

Sam Huff has completed and submitted the latest stakeholder PROS questionnaire.

Certificate of Deposit Maturity and Renewal
