Community Outreach Efforts are news this year!

Over the years, West Sound Disc Golf Association members have brought the fun of our sport to a variety of events: Bremerton Parks summer clinics, Kitsap Family Fun Run, and the Kitsap County Fair to name just a few. This year we were invited to some new venues. Portable baskets were put into play on the grounds of the Bremerton YMCA, on Linder Field during Whaling Days, in Battle Point Park on Bainbridge Island, and at the South Kitsap Back to School event. New information brochures were written, printed and distributed.



A summer clinic for kids on Bainbridge Island was led by Paul and Pam Wright. Funds from the Bainbridge Park Department registration fees may be used to purchase baskets if there is enough local interest in putting in a course at Battle Point Park.

The South Kitsap Back to School Expo was a huge success, with more than 5000 people in attendance.

We're looking forward to another busy year of promoting disc golf, and interested members are invited to participate. Contact any Board Member for more information. This year we hope to add local Boy Scouts to our scheduled activities.



In May, our presence was established on Facebook. This has provided a new communication tool and fun way to share photos and updates.

Joe Feidt's three page article concludes "The West Sounders have accomplished much in a relatively short time. They've proved you don't have to be an established club to get

They've installed and are now maintaining several courses and anyone who has installed and maintained a course knows how much work this requires. They're also building membership steadily; they're hosting events aimed at all skill levels; and they've established a solid legal structure-501(c)3-to provide financial stability and plan for the future. That's a promising start for a young club."


West Sound Ice Bowl January 21


The mission of the West Sound Challenge Series is to encourage friendly competition among the local players by creating a format for individual play and a series of organ-

ized group events. Based on feedback throughout the year, the West Sound Challenge is meeting its goal of bringing the disc golf community together at all skill levels. The season started April 14th and finished on September 9th. The Saturday morning "Monthly" Events were held at each of the local courses. There were a total of 170 unique players in the series and each "Monthly" had from 57 to 84 players. One prize was awarded at each "Monthly" based on skill. The rest of the prizes were awarded completely at random by the use of a raffle. At the final event, trophies were awarded based on the overall point totals of the best four finishes at the "Monthlies." Congratulations to Brian Thornton (Open), Sean Herman (Amateur), Mike Foster (Grandmasters), Amanda Nelson (Women) in the Series Points Titles. Also, special thanks to the players who helped me with running each Event. It takes a lot of help to make an event run smoothly."




WBDGW World's Biggest Disc Golf Weekend May 5-6

Five no cost events over two days, including a beginner clinic hosted by Discraft Pro Scott Papa, "Tiki" themed doubles, and the region's first ever "Roc vs Buzzz" event were well attended. 2013 is gearing up to be a great weekend as always.
